SITE

The grapes for this wine grow in the highest section of the Sea Eagle vineyard in Finniss River, a sub region of the Adelaide Hills about 25 km southeast of McLaren Vale. The Alttus is exclusively produced in best years, and only released after a longer ripening period in the bottle.

VINIFICATION

Harvest mid of March 2018. This single vineyard wine is fermented in open fermenters for 20 days, pump over and push down. Transfer into barrels for malolactic fermentation. Aged for 18 months in 300-liter hogsheads. New French oak only.

TASTING NOTES

Intense dark red, gorgeously focused. A big wine that manages a sense of elegance along with its deep, peppery plum and blackberry flavours, which mingle enticingly on the firm, finely tuned long finish. A wine that has power, grace and charm in equal parts. Excellent aging potential. Decanting recommended.

FOOD PAIRING

Steak, braised beef with aromatic sauce, flavorful game such as hare or wild boar.

Excellent ageing potential, thirty years +.
